





The Foundation also hosted its first Pig Roast held at the Deep River Yacht and Tennis club. Patrons were treated to a delicious meal and a great night.




Communications and Awareness

The x-ray diagnostic imaging equipment is here and construction has been completed for the general x-ray imaging suite, allowing complete use by the end of March 2020. Upgrades to receive the ultrasound equipment has begun. With the help of our board members, volunteers, partners, and of course donors, we are going to see this through and reach our goal.
